

## The Tzadik - The Righteous Man

Requirement	Reminder	Reputation
1. You shall have <b>no other gods</b> before Me.	The <b>forehead</b> , where we place the <i>tefillin shel rosh</i> . Hashem must be first in our thoughts.	He is <b>conscious of his relationship</b> to Israel - and HASHEM.
2. You shall <b>not make for yourself an idol</b> , or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth.	The <b>eyes</b> , which are used to stray from HASHEM.	He <b>guards his eyes</b> to protect his family from shame.
3. You shall <b>not take the name of HASHEM your G-d in vain</b> , for HASHEM will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain.	The <b>mouth</b> , which holds the tongue, which must be tamed.	He <b>does not cause a man</b> to feel inferior, ridiculed or ashamed.
4. <b>Observe the Sabbath day</b> to keep it holy, as HASHEM your G-d commanded you.	The <b>neck</b> , which we stiffen against HASHEM and fail to keep His commandments.	His <b>reverence and excitement for the Sabbath</b> is contagious.
5. <b>Honor your father and your mother</b> , as HASHEM your G-d has commanded you, that your days may be prolonged and that it may go well with you on the land which HASHEM your G-d gives you.	The <b>arms</b> , where we place the <i>tefillin shel yad</i> , in obedience to our heavenly Father. The two arms represent our father and mother, in that order.	He <b>honors the wise man and the learned man</b> , recognizing their experience and dedication.
6. You shall <b>not murder</b> .	The <b>heart</b> , which follows after our eyes, and reveals our thoughts of anger and hatred.	He has a <b>love for the Scriptures</b> that inspires others to study and know HASHEM.
7. You shall <b>not commit adultery</b> .	The <b>hips</b> , which is where men and women differ. In this place we recognize the sign of the covenant, not the tool of the flesh.	He <b>avoids appearances of evil</b> before they occur - and purposes in his heart beforehand how he will respond.
8. You shall <b>not steal</b> .	The <b>right leg</b> , which we use to run from our sin.	He is <b>known to lend or give</b> more often than borrow.
9. You shall <b>not bear false witness</b> against your neighbor.	The <b>left leg</b> , which follows after the right, as lying follows theft.	He <b>swears to his own hurt</b> . His word is known to be unquestioned.
10. You shall <b>not covet</b> your neighbor's wife, and you shall not desire your neighbor's house, his field or his male servant or his female servant, his ox or his donkey or anything that belongs to your neighbor.	The <b>feet</b> , which take us to the place our heart desires - whether right or wrong. These feet should bring peace to our neighbor.	A <b>consummate family man</b> , never participating or encouraging jokes about marriage or family.
